2. Admittance to this written test is provisional only. Detailed scrutiny of the applications/credentials will be conducted before interview/appointment. Any discrepancy found during the detailed scrutiny will result in the rejection of candidature.
3. Candidates should occupy their seats in the test hall with the Admit Card at least 30 minutes before the commencement of written test for the purpose of verification of identity. **Candidates reaching the test hall 15 minutes after commencement of the written test (after 10:45 am) will not be admitted.**
4. Candidates should affix their self attested photograph (taken within six months) in the space provided on the admit card.
5. Candidates will not be admitted for the test without producing any one of the following **Original Identity Proof** along with the duly completed Admit Card: *Voters Identity Card, Passport, Driving License, AADHAAR card issued by the Central Government.*
6. Candidates without Admit Card and ID Proof will not be admitted to the test hall.
7. This test consists of **100 Multiple Choice Questions** covering Subject Knowledge, General English, Reasoning Ability, Numerical Ability and General Knowledge. Each multiple choice question carries one mark and there will be no negative marks. A separate OMR answer sheet will be given to mark the answers.
8. Each question is provided with four answer choices (a), (b), (c) and (d). You may mark your choice by darkening the bubble corresponding to the question number using **Blue or Black Ball-Point Pen** in the OMR Answer Sheet. No other colour pen or pencil should be used.
9. Read the instructions on the OMR sheet. Do not tamper with the barcode in the OMR answer sheet. Signature should be put in the space provided in the OMR sheet in the presence of the invigilator.
10. Use of mobile phone, calculator, books or any other paper/material will not be permitted in the test hall.
11. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the examination hall before completion of the written test.
12. Candidates should return the **Question Booklet, OMR answer sheet and the admit card** to the invigilator before leaving the test hall.
